

Low Emission Hub – Get Started Guide

The Low Emission Hub is a central information hub for Low Emission Strategies (LES) providing information on potential interventions and their impacts. The Hub includes an extensive searchable database of UK case studies and related resources. There are three main elements to the Hub:

- A **searchable database of case studies** – these can be searched through a simple quick search, an advanced search option and geographically via a map;
- A set of related **resources and tools** – that provide additional information to help local authority practitioners assess Low Emission strategy measures;
- A **MyHub** area – where a user can register and login to select and save case studies to view later, comment on case studies and upload their case studies to share with other users.

Low Emission Hub overview

All aspects of the Low Emission Hub can be accessed through the home page and throughout the site via the menu bar as shown below:

MyHub registration and login

You can register and login through the MyHub Login page. To register you need to enter your name, email and a password. The moderator will then activate your MyHub account.

When your account is activated you will be able to:

- Select and save case studies to view later
- Comment on case studies
- Upload new and edit existing case studies

Further details on all these functions can be found in the MyHub admin guide. Anyone can use the site without logging in to search and view public case studies, but you will not be able to view all case studies, select or comment on case studies or upload new ones.

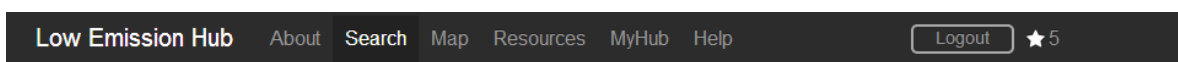

Searching the case studies

You can carry out a quick search by simply filtering by case study type:

- Fleet – Case studies based around managed fleets (e.g. council owned fleet)
- Site – Case studies based around managed sites (e.g. a new development)
- Area – Case study based around a geographic area (e.g. 'town centre', 'an arterial corridor' or an entire 'council area')
- Framework – Case studies based on strategies or policies which provide a framework for action, but do not describe specific actions applied to specific fleets, sites or areas.

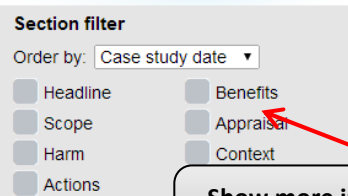
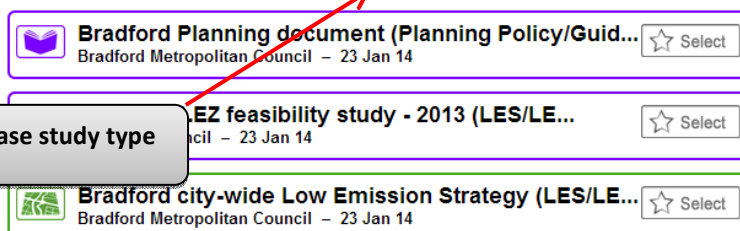
Quick | Advanced
